June 5 to 28 - Andrew Martin

#### Artist's Remarkable Collection Comes Home



Northwind will be presenting a very special show, June 5 to 28, exhibiting selected paintings, drawings and sculpture of the late Andrew Martin (1923 – 1997). Son of a French sculptor, Martin was born in Paris in 1923, and lived among artists from his earliest years. He studied at L'Ecole des Beaux Arts and the Art Institute of Chicago.

In 1953, he joined the cooperative Hansa Gallery in Manhattan, which gained renown as a showplace for the avant garde painters of the period. He returned to Paris in the early 60s, incorporating in his work the traditional concerns of European painters. In 1964, he joined the faculty of the University of North Carolina – Greensboro, where he worked and taught studio courses for the next 30 years.

Martin's is an extraordinarily fine body of work that is not widely known. It enables the viewer to step through the periods of art history from the 1940s to the 1990s, and captures the influence of abstract expressionist ideas on the contemporary figurative painting of his time.

There will be a reception at the gallery during Art Walk on June 6 from 5:30 to 8 PM. A Coffee Talk will be held featuring the artist's wife, Laureen Martin, on Friday, June 12 at 7 PM. Poets sign up when they arrive; a turn at the microphone comes when Jim pulls your name from a cup. Jim likes to think these relaxed gatherings give us a bit of San Francisco in downtown Port Townsend.

### Arts for Elders - Back from the Brink

**Arts to Elders** has been rescued by the **Port Townsend Arts Commission** with a grant of \$1,000 to fund the May and June programs. In addition, a grant application for \$2,000 from the **Jefferson County Community Foundation** has been awarded to this valuable program. These two grants will enable Northwind to continue the Arts to Elders Program through December of 2009.

**The Arts to Elders program** seeks to involve the elderly residing in senior residences and care facilities in arts and humanities presentations. The program has been in operation since July of

2007. Sylvia White is responsible for writing grants and finding donations to support the program. Harvey Putterman is the Program Director and works closely with the artists and the Activity Directors at each venue. His commitment of time and energy has made this program a wonderful success and we are sad that he plans to step down. Therefore we are looking for a new Director for this modestly paid position.
